AUTISM

This toolkit is designed to help support custody staff when they interact with autistic people in police custody. It contains a series of resources for both custody staff and detainees. Many of the resources included in this toolkit may also help support custody staff when interacting with other detainees.

The resources have been co-developed by a group of autistic people, police officers and academics at the University of Nottingham called the Nottinghamshire Autism Police Partnership.
